Children must be able to engage in a 2-way conversation and work independently in a group environment to attend this program.


Social Skills curriculum: *Superflex®: A Superhero Social Thinking Curriculum* by Michelle Garcia Winner

Social Skills include:

- ♦ SOCIAL THINKING—learn how social information is part of the brain and how to modify our behaviours using Superflexible strategies to increase self-monitoring and self-awareness skills
- ◆ PERSPECTIVE TAKING—thinking about others (someone else's point of view) and expected behaviours
- FLEXIBILITY—understand more about their own flexible and not-so-flexible thinking, socially and behaviourally
- ♦ SOCIAL SMARTS—when to use social smarts by increasing awareness of their own thoughts and behaviours

Skills are taught through video-modeling, discussion, scripted role-playing and engagement through facilitated games and activities. Take home assignments of the skills that were taught during each session will be provided to families to give them an opportunity to practice and maintain the skills throughout the week.

Our Social Skills Program is a **9-week** program, starting **January 10th, 2018** and will be held on Wednesdays at Exceptional Minds Learning Academy:
